HIGHLIGHTING OUR STUDENTS AND STAFF

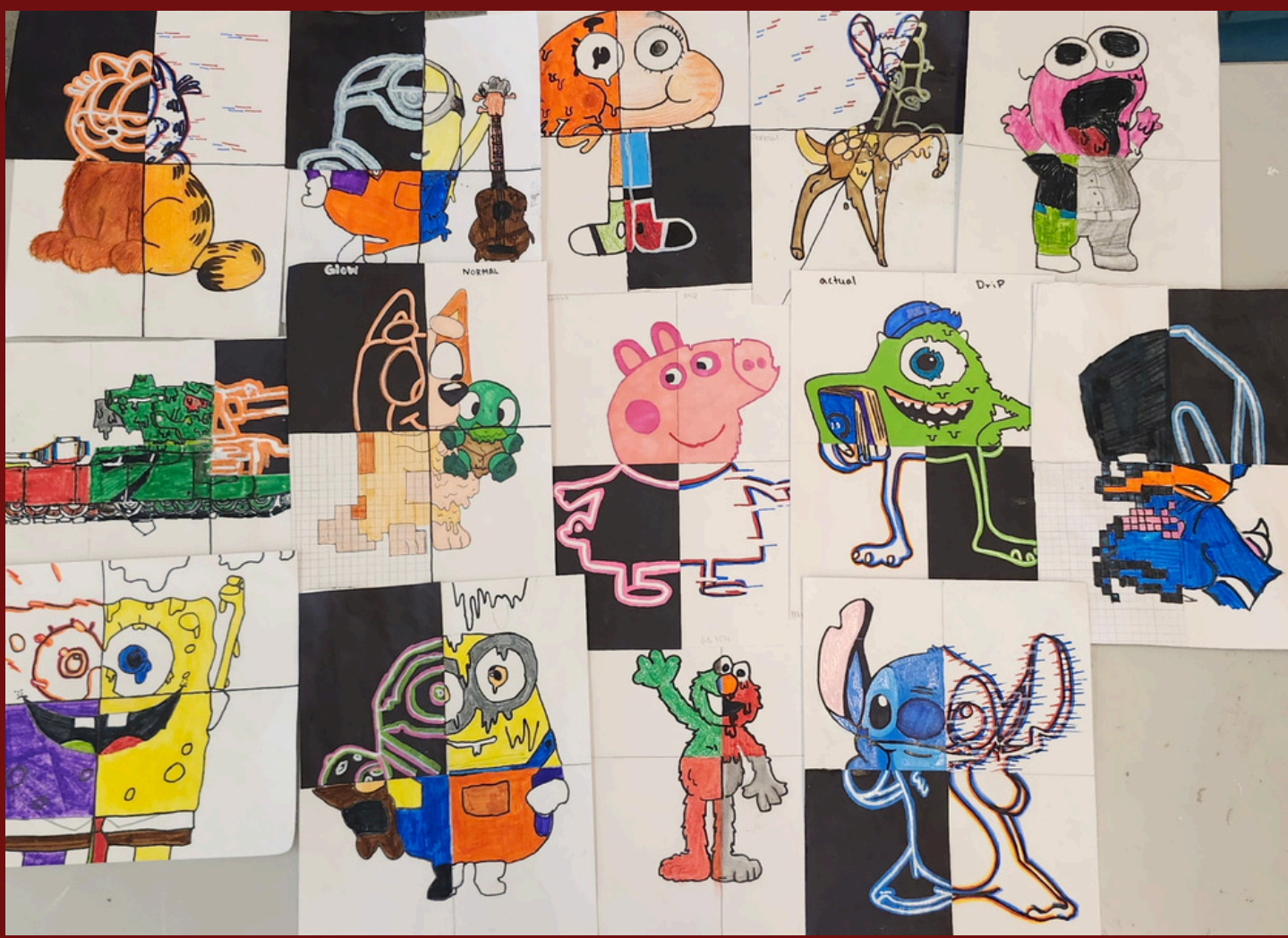


This year, the third grade students in Mrs. Bantz's class have had an important role of serving as Junior Janitors as part of our school's *Leader in Me* leadership program.
