North Linn High School Late Arrival/Early Release Contract

The late arrival/early release privilege offers Junior/Senior students the opportunity to arrive late or leave early if their schedule permits and they are not on the D/F list.

Guidelines for the Late Arrival/Early Release program are as follows:

- 1. Juniors and Seniors who do not have morning class may arrive late. "Late" is defined as, after the official start of the school day but before the start of the student's first class meeting for the day. Students arriving late must enter the building and sign in at the office and wait in the library until the bell rings.
- 2. Juniors and Seniors who do not have afternoon classes may leave after their last scheduled class. They must sign out in the office prior to leaving.
- 3. Late Arrival/Early Release will be revisited every midterm and quarter. Students with D's and/or F's at midterms and/or quarters, Late Arrival/Early Release will be revoked until the student's grades are all at or above C's. This includes Kirkwood midterm grades and monthly Kirkwood grade checks.
- 4. Late Arrival/Early Release applies only with consecutive periods at the beginning of the day or the end of the day.
- 5. Students must leave campus after signing out for the day.
- 6. If a student with Late Arrival/Early Release needs to come in early or stay for a school-related reason such as meeting with a teacher or an extracurricular activity, the student will need to check in at the office.
