## School Health Requirements

## **Physicals**

School policy states a child must have a physical examination dated the year that your child enters Kindergarten. A preschool physical is not acceptable.

## **Immunizations**

Children entering school are required by lowa law to have the following immunizations prior to entering school.

**DPT/DT**: 5 doses, with at least one dose received on or after 4 years of age **Polio**: 4 doses, with at least one dose received on or after 4 years of age

MMR: 2 doses; with the first dose on or after 12 months of age and the second dose no less than 28

days after the 1st dose

**Hepatitis B**: at least three doses

Varicella: 2 doses received on or after 12 months of age, unless the child has a reliable history of

natural disease

A signed certificate of immunization is required on the first day of school. Complete dates (month, day and year received) must be included on this card. Don't forget to include the source, the doctor, clinic, etc, where the immunizations were given. A physician, physician assistant, nurse or certified medical assistant may sign the card. Your child will not be able to attend school if this record of immunization is not on file at the school.
